GERBKOV, Georg (Sergievitch).  
(ZHERBKOV)

Munich

6 "GRAIN" stage name during 1930-35.  
8 Georg WOLKOW - used since Jan 1946 to evade  
recognition by the Soviets.

Born: 20 June 1908 at Novo/Cherkovsk, (Novo/Tscherkask), Russia.

Marital Status: Single. Sometimes passes his fiancee off as his wife. At last report she was in Berlin.

Citizenship: Russian prior to 1920. Now claims to be Stateless. Washington report claims he acquired German citizenship after settling in Berlin 1931.

Residence: Pickelstrasse 15, Muenchen/Forstei; Herr Schnitzer. Lives with a Swede national, Frau Jakobson, who works "for the Americans". -----OR-----  
22 Lampadiusstrasse, Munchen, Oberbayern.

Description: height 1.70m; weight 70 kg; erect posture; black hair; round face; ruddy complexion;

- 1920 - 1927 - Fled Russia through Constantinople to Yugoslavia. Attended Military Academy at Belgrade. Studied one year at the U. of Zagreb.  
1928 - 1935 - Lived in Paris as a ballet instructor and singer. With the Russian Ballet visited Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Uruguay, Mexico, Algeria, Tunis, Czechoslovakia, Belgium, Luxembourg. Made two visits to Berlin stayed with his cousin, Nina Melhose, Berlin/Wannsee, summers '32&34.  
1935 - 1940 - In August went to Berlin and worked as a voice instructor till 1940 when the German Ministry of the Interior made him a proposition to recruit his services in enlisting the White Russian emigres for (over)

an anti-Soviet work. Went to Paris and worked for the German Innerministerium conducting and instructing the White Russians living in Paris until 1944.  
During 1943 was introduced to VLASSOV and from then on acted as his representative.  
French sources state he was an office worker of the Gestapo and an SS Sergeant.  
August 1944: Accompanied the Germans when they left Paris, immediately before the liberation.

Where contacted: Observed in Munich during February 1946. On 4 March FLUSH made personal contact with GERBKOV.

Control Factors: Wanted by the French for "intelligence avec l'ennemi". Subject is "scared to death" of being returned to Russia.
