CAMMIN: Liquidation of Project, Exit Permit, etc.

MGM-A-2695.

1. In accordance with instructions contained in reference letter, CAMMIN has been informed that we will drop him at the end of September. It is unfortunately not equally simple to dispose of the matter of the exit permit. For one thing, the matter had already been arranged with Mr. Urmann of the Combined Travel Board, before your MGM-A-2695 arrived here. If we withdraw our sponsorship, it is fairly certain that CAMMIN will not receive the necessary exit permit. In order not to renege on our promises to CAMMIN and in order not to endanger our good relations with Mr. Urmann who is a busy and slightly irascible man who has been kind enough to cooperate with us in this and other matters, we prefer to leave matters as they are.

2. All is not lost, however, CAMMIN has applied for a six-months' stay in Spain and if he finds that there are no opportunities there for him to earn a livelihood and to work "pour la bonne cause", he will either return to Germany or emigrate to South America where he also has friends. He had already been informed that there was no interest in the use of his services before the arrival of MGM-A-2695. Since that time, he has been instructed that there is no American intelligence service in Spain (only "observers") and that it would be absolutely fruitless for him to address himself to any American agency there such as the embassy. He understands this quite well and has stated that he will make no attempt to contact any American individual or agency while in Spain. If you wish, we can get him to sign a statement to this effect prior to his departure.

3. CAMMIN's request for the exit permit has gone through

the German mill and he lacks only the notarized statement attesting his lack of nationality. The papers will enter the American side of the mill next week. We anticipate that he will have left Germany by the end of September. Maria Kuznetzova of Leusanne, the well-known diva, is paying his plane fare.
