established to the satisfaction of the Commission as follows:

Character:

that the Principal Applicant and spouse are of good  
character and behavior;

that the Principal Applicant and spouse are not and have not  
been member(s) of, or participated in, any movement which is or  
has been hostile to the United States or the form of Government  
of the United States.

History:

that the Principal Applicant was born on 9 January 1908 at  
Linstained, Lithuania;

that his spouse, Juzepija, maiden name VALCISKAIKYTE, was born  
on 20 December 1903 at Vadektiliai, Lithuania;

that they were married on 10 October 1932 at Linnas, Lithuania;

that from 1936 to 1940 the Principal Applicant was in the employ of  
the Lithuanian Government at Alytus;

that he was held as a political prisoner at Kamiai from 1940 to 1941  
by the Communists;

that from 1941 to August 1944 he was an active member in the Lith-  
uanian Anti-Nazi Resistance movement in Lithuania;

that he entered Germany on 2 August 1944;

that upon entry he worked in an aluminum factory near Jamburg until  
the war's end in 1945;

that he has since continuously resided in Displaced Persons Camps  
in the U.S. Zone, employed by the camp authorities;

that he was a resident of an IDO assembly Center on 1 January 1946  
and that he is presently residing at Displaced Persons Camp Rimarck,  
Schwabisch-Bronn, with his spouse;

3. By virtue of the foregoing, the Commission finds:

that the Principal Applicant is a displaced person eligible  
for admission into the United States under Section 1(c) of  
the Act, and that such admission would be in accordance with the  
regulations of the Commission; see additional statement on page 2 of  
this report;

that Juzepija is also eligible for admission as the spouse of  
the Principal Applicant;

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that the Principal Applicant is entitled to SECOND PRIORITY under Section 8 (b) of the Act, for the reason that he is needed in the locality in the United States where he will reside. He is also entitled to SECOND PRIORITY under Section 7 of the Act, for the reason that he was residing in an IED Assembly Center on 1 January 1948, as certified by IED.

4. Therefore, in accordance with Section 700.9(c) of the regulations, this report is submitted to the Director of the US Foreign Service at Washington, D. C., for consideration in connection with the subject's application for an immigration visa.
