SUBJECT: Emigration of Former V-15775 and V-15777

REF: Your Memo Nr. 183/56 of 10 August 1956

1. In accordance with your request contained in Reference, we have inquired of the US Consulate General, Munich, regarding the emigration status of Subjects.

2. The US Consulate General, Munich, advises that the case files of Subjects are currently in Munich, having been transferred there from Stuttgart. The Munich Consulate is still awaiting a final screening report from the IRP in Stuttgart. To the best of the Vice Consul's knowledge there appear to be no complications which might militate against the issuance of a visa for emigration, unless, of course, the IRP issues an unfavorable or derogatory screening report.

3. We shall attempt to follow the progress of the case through the US Consulate General, Munich, and will notify you regarding the arrival of the IRP report.
