1. A name check in CIC Central Registry revealed the following possible traces on Subject:

a. A report prepared by 7707 ECIC, evaluated C-3, dated 18 August 1949 lists one Lt. Col GOLUB as Chief Engineer of Field Fortification Division No. 23 which is a subordinate unit of the Engineer Section, Headquarters, Group of Occupation Forces, Germany.

The report contains the following personalia concerning this individual: "Technical and organizational duties and supervision of division's construction projects; highly skilled construction engineer with a fine reputation among his superior officers, respected and popular with subordinates because of his fairness and mild, sympathetic nature; Ukrainian; university graduate; Party member, more of an opportunist than a true Communist; about 5'10" tall, stout, black hair, brown eyes, round thick face; drinks occasionally and likes parties; very avid hunter and fisherman; married; two children; family lives in Oberschoeneweide (294), Soviet Zone of Germany.

The above information is dated 7 Jan 1949.

b. A report prepared by 7707 ECIC, evaluated C-3, dated 20 Sept 49, lists one Lt. Col GOLUB as Chief Engineer of Field Fortification Division No. 23, a section of Soviet Army Fortification Dept. No. 27, located at Oberschoeneweide near Berlin.

The Division is subordinate to the Office Chief of Engineers, Potsdam and works in close cooperation with the Soviet Military Administration. The report states that the Division sublets part of its contracts to various German firms.

The above information is dated 1946 to Jan 1949.

2. The source of the information contained in the above reports is listed as a Soviet civilian defector who served as a hydro-geological engineer with the 5th Geographical Division from August 1943 to Jan 1949.

3. A check of CIC records revealed the following information concerning Field Post Office No. 25 981:
