1. If the physical description (especially the size) of Identity 2's friend Col. GOLUB permits sure identification with the Col. GOLUB of MGBA-2902, you may be interested in the following extract from HT-851-51 of 7 September 1951, source Soviet defector Sergei Mikhailovich SIMIN:

a. Name: GOLUB Rank: Lt. Col. Arm: Engr.  
Position: Chief Engineer, APO 75463 Age: Over 40  
Height: 175 cm. Weight: 100 kgs.  
Build: Stout Hair: Brunet  
Personality: Energetic  
Military history: Left Germany in 1950 for Odessa

b. Soviet Engineer construction unit APO 75463 was in Berlin from 1949 until 1950, when it moved to Leipzig; source states it was still in Leipzig at the time of his defection in August 1951.

c. EUCOM comment: Information on GOLUB confirms previous reports.

2. Identity 2 has stated (MGBA-8367) that he has known GOLUB in Germany since 1946, but did not mention any visit to the USSR by GOLUB in 1950. Note that GIC's latest information (MGBA-2902) is dated 1949, and the only proof of Identity 2's contact with GOLUB (attachment to MGBA-8264) is dated 1946.
