Bonn Contacts of Werner Frans GLASHNAPP

RE: EGBA-42106, 6 June 1957

1. Since the preparation of referenced dispatch, we have continued to investigate the activities of Werner GLASHNAPP through all facilities available to us. Although we have determined that he is directly involved with a variety of highly questionable West Berliners, we have not, as yet, been able to establish any clear connection between him and the MFS.

2. We have long known that GLASHNAPP is a regular visitor in Bonn, deals with official Bonn ministries in connection with federal building contracts and uses a Bonn letter drop. Despite this, we have not been able to develop any information about his contacts in Bonn. A recent intercept on his phone, however, may provide a means for developing information regarding his Bonn contacts and activities. To wit: On 13 March GLASHNAPP talked with a female from Bonn who uses the telephone number 27018. Although the conversation consisted mainly of double-talk and was, therefore, for the most part unintelligible, the female involved clearly is a close associate of GLASHNAPP's and is knowledgeable regarding several of GLASHNAPP's contacts. In view of this, we request that you check with CIS in Frankfurt in an attempt to determine the name of the subscriber to the above number. We are hopeful that it may lead us to an identification of GLASHNAPP's Bonn letter drop and provide us with an opportunity to request coverage. We continue to believe that GLASHNAPP very likely is an Eastern agent.
