

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TECHNICAL INTERROGATION REPORT

SUBJECT: CAINFER (IDEN A)

IRD: #72263

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

1. Subject of this SGSWIRL interrogation is a 56 year old widower German male who is being considered for clandestine employment by Hamburg Base. This was conducted on 25 October 1968 in Kiel, Germany.

ISSUES:

2. [] requested this SGSWIRL examination to assist in determining whether:

- a) Subject has told us the full extent of his involvement in "war crimes";
- b) Subject has revealed his relationship with WOLADY to unauthorized persons;
- c) Subject maintains any relationship with any other intelligence service;
- d) Subject contacted us for protection against future prosecution by the German court.

DETAILS:

3. Who Knows: Subject advised that he has informed his youngest daughter, Christina, about his current involvement with the WOLADY intelligence. He stated that he apprised her of this relationship as he felt "every intelligence operative has to confide in someone". SGSWIRLwise there are no indications that he has apprised anyone else of this covert relationship with WOLADY intelligence. This is supported by Subject's answers to the following:

Did you tell Christina about your contact with us? Yes.
Besides Christina did you tell anyone about your contact with us? No.

Did you tell Heinke about your relationship with us? No.
(Heinke is a tenant residing in an apartment owned by Subject with whom Subject is having an elicit affair. She is at the same time living in common law with a man in the above mentioned apartment.)

4. The Venlo Affair: Subject was questioned concerning his involvement in the Venlo Affair of 9 November 1939. He advised that he has not withheld from either the German authorities or from us his true participation in this incident. He openly admitted having fired first at IDEN B and that he felt that his bullet struck him. He stated, however, that he is not positive in view of the fact that the other persons in his detail began firing immediately after his first shot. Subject stated that he was a good shot and probably killed IDEN B. He claims he admitted this to German authorities and this was substantiated by his answers to these questions:

Do you know exactly who shot IDEN B? No.
Do you think your bullet hit IDEN B? Yes.
Do you know exactly if your bullet hit IDEN B? No.
Did you deliberately hide from us any details about the Venlo Affair? No.

5. Other War Crimes: Subject was questioned concerning any involvement in any other war crimes or the withholding of additional information and evidence which could possibly be used against him in future prosecution by the German courts. Subject stated that to the

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best of his knowledge there is no other evidence outstanding for which he could again be brought to trial, and he denied involvements in any other war crimes. He added that he has no reason to fear subsequent prosecution because of new evidence that could be developed since there is none. He denied further that it was his intention to develop a relationship with LNHARP as part of a defense in case of further prosecution or as an insurance against any such prosecution by German authorities. It appears that he has been substantially truthful to the following:

Are you hiding any war crimes from us? No.
Are you hiding any evidence that the German court could use against you? No.
Do you have any reasons for contacting us that you are hiding? No.
Did you contact us in order to get protection from the war crimes' court? No.
Is it your intention to use your relationship with us for protection? No.
Did you tell the German courts you were in contact with WOLADY intelligence? No.

6. Subject's relationship with IDEN C: Subject advised that when he apprised police authorities of his intended travel to Madrid for vacation in 1966, they informed him off handedly that he "could go see IDEN C" since he was now living there. Subject stated that since he admired this man, he did contact him while in Madrid and the nature of the contact was purely personal to renew an old friendship. He stated that they reminisced about le bon vieux temps. He added that he had no contact with IDEN C subsequent to World War II prior to this meeting in 1966 and that there has been no contact since 1966. Subject's answers to the following substantiate this contention:

Did you visit IDEN C in 1966? Yes.
Are you corresponding with IDEN C? No.
Are you hiding any details about your relationship with IDEN C? No.

7. Other intelligence activities: Subject stated that aside from his former relationship with the SS, he has not engaged in any type of intelligence activities. His answers to the following questions support that he has been truthful:

Is your true name IDEN A? Yes.
Were you a member of the SS? Yes.
As a member of the SS, did you work for German intelligence? Yes.
Are you now working for any intelligence service? No.
Are you now working for any German (East or West) intelligence service? No.
Are you now working for any Soviet or Communist Service? No.
Did any government direct you to contact the WOLADIES? No.
Are you hiding from us any intelligence work you did before 1945? No.
Are you now a member of NPD? No.
Did the NPD direct you to contact the WOLADIES? No.
Do you now have any relationship with the NPD you are hiding from us? No.
