1. The information given with para.2 was received from HH 1; the information given with para.3 is based on confidential report with Salzburg Security Office.

2. Erich KERNMAYR's junior assistant and private secretary Lothar GREIL visited the former SS officer Heinz KOGLGRUBER at Linz, Schillerstrasse 36, employs with the 'Wardstern-Versicherung', Mühlviertel agency, and proposed to him to work for a new intelligence organization of Erich KERNMAYR's. Such group would work for FSS, but for a special detachment run by conservatives. The main interest assigned to the new organization would be internal political intelligence, especially on OeVP and OP, military information ranking only second. KOGLGRUBER refused.

3. KERNMAYR frequently comes to Salzburg and on such occasion meets with Dr. Georg SAUSENG, his old political and personal friend.

Dr. Georg SAUSENG, accountant, born 15 May 1887 at Gnas, Austrian citizen, without religious confession, married, living at Salzburg, Gartnerstrasse 8.

SAUSENG's main occupation is to organize the sale of KERNMAYR's (Erich TARN's) publications. He is an active member of Nationale Liga, but nothing is known about his role as intermediary between KERNMAYR and Dr. Adolf SLAVIK.
