The letter forwarded with Reference was sent to ODENVY with a request for information on Hanns FISCHER. According to information in ODENVY files, which can be passed to CATIDE, Hanns FISCHER was born in Nuernberg on 22 May 1900. He entered the United States on 4 September 1923 and was naturalized on 8 January 1929 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. He reportedly is a well-educated individual and has been employed as a writer, editor, foreign correspondent and translator. During 1941 information was received that FISCHER was the recipient of German propaganda sent from Russia or Germany via Siberia. He allegedly published the first newspaper for the Nazi Party and was supposedly a friend of Hitler. FISCHER has not come to the attention of ODENVY in recent years.
