Reference A pertains to a Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) memorandum dated 20 March 1981 regarding Haskel Wexler and the allegations set forth that he is producing a film dealing with a CIA-controlled underground city. According to sources, Wexler is producing this film for the Pentagon or an unnamed Congressman. (S)

2. While conducting file reviews on another matter, information relating to Haskel Wexler appeared in the file of Georgiy Enverovich Mamedov, Second Secretary, Soviet Embassy, Washington, D.C. According to a Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) cable dated 14 July 1978, Mamedov was in contact with Ralph Stavins of the Institute for Policy Studies (IPS) on 28 June 1978. The conversation evolved around IPS's documentary entitled "The Case Officer." Stavins stated that the film was produced by Saul Landau and photographed by Haskel Wexler, who had previously won Academy Award. (S)
