HEUSINGER, Adolf

1. General Adolf HEUSINGER and his wife have, during the past year, discussed with [] their desire to visit Venice, Italy, with the Harrisons. I have encouraged [] to accept this proposal since HEUSINGER has, over a long period of time, been a valuable contact of this Base and has provided us with considerable information of value to KNEBARK.
2. Although HEUSINGER will defray his own expenses, some miscellaneous minor costs concerned with entertainment will be involved. Also, [] will transport the HEUSINGERS in his own privately owned automobile.
3. I have instructed [] to inform General HEUSINGER that he will be able to make the trip in May. I feel that [] should receive reimbursement for the miscellaneous costs involved in entertainment during the trip, should make the trip on a personal duty status and should receive reimbursement for mileage.
