REFERENCE: Memorandum from DORE to EAD, subject
as above, 24 July 1951

1. The undersigned telephoned Mr. Melville Ruggles, DRE, Department of State, and informed him that this office would have no objection to the Department's use of Dr. Hilgar in connection with the project involving Soviet leadership for a period of approximately 6 months, providing the Department was willing to permit Dr. Hilgar to consult with this office and to prepare short papers for us during this period. Mr. Ruggles said that this arrangement would be entirely satisfactory to the Department.

2. With reference to Mr. Ruggles' question as to the type of clearance which had been granted for Dr. Hilgar, it was suggested to Mr. Ruggles that since Dr. Hilgar would be working for the Department on this project that Mr. Ruggles should obtain a clearance from the security unit of the Department since the clearance that this office is operating under only pertains to Dr. Hilgar's activities with CIA. I informed Mr. Ruggles that the CIA clearance for Dr. Hilgar does not include top secret material.

3. In accordance with paragraph 3 of the reference memorandum, it is requested that the details concerning the loan of Dr. Hilgar to the Department for the next 6 months be worked out by C with Dr. Hilgar and Mr. Ruggles.
