GUNNE WAS INTERVIEWED ON SEPTEMBER 13, 1983, AND HIS STATEMENT CLOSELY APPROXIMATED THE INFORMATION IN NAZI WAR CRIMES DISCLOSURE ACT HIS BDC FILE (REF B), WITH ONLY A FEW CHANGES. DURING INTERVIEW APPLICANT BECAME QUITE EMOTIONAL: WHEN CONOFF 2000 REMARKED WHAT A GOOD MEMORY APPLICANT HAD OF DATES, FACTS ETC. HE BEGAN TO CRY AND SAID NINE YEARS IN PRISON--A YEAR AND A HALF SPENT IN SOLITARY CONFINEMENT--CIA HAS NO OBJECTION TO GAVE ONE MUCH TIME TO THINK ABOUT ONE'S LIFE.

OCTOBER 1934-OCTOBER 1935: MILITARY SERVICE IN ROMANIAN ARMY, IN WHICH HE REACHED RANK OF CORPORAL (NOTE: APPLICANT DENIED 2ND LT RANK CITED PARA 3 REFTEL B.) OCTOBER 1935-AUGUST 1939: ECONOMIC AND NEWS EDITOR OF THE DEUTSCHE TAGESZEITUNG (NEWSPAPER OF THE GERMAN VOLKS PARTEI OF ROMANIA--A NAZI ORGANIZATION IN ROMANIA). AUGUST 1939: JOINED "GERMANIA" REGIMENT (SS). SEPTEMBER 1939-JULY 1940: DETAILED TO GERMAN LEGATION IN BUCHAREST TO ASSIST IN RESETTLEMENT OF ETHNIC GERMANS / FROM BESSARABIA AND BERKOVINA TO WARTHEGAU. DECEMBER 1940-MARCH 1941: IN BUCHAREST WITH GERMAN LEGA-TTON. MARCH 1941-MAY 1942: TRAINING IN MUNICH (RETURNED TO SAME SS ARTILLERY UNIT--APPLICANT SAID HE WAS IN THE 6TH BATTERY VICE 6TH REGIMENT CITED REFTEL B.) MAY-JULY 1942: WITH THE FIRST ARTILLERY REGIMENT OF THE SS DIVISION "ADOLF HITLER" IN TAGAUROG, USSR. JULY-AUGUST 1942: IN A RESERVE UNIT IN FRANCE (OF THE 15TH ARMY) USED AGAINST THE DIEPPE LANDING. AUGUST-DECEMBER 1942: OFFICER TRAINING IN THE "JUNKER SCHULE" IN BAD TOLZ. JANUARY-FEBRUARY 1943: RETRAINING IN A ROCKET ARTILLERY UNTT . FEBRUARY 1943-JANUARY 1944: FIRST SS CORPS SECTION; TRANSFERRED TO KHARKOV. NAME OF UNIT CHANGED TO 2ND SS CORPS (PANZER); RENAMED THE 50 2ND CORPS ROCKET SECTION. JANUARY-MAY 1944: IN FRANCE (ALENCON). MAY-AUGUST 1944: TRANSFERRED TO LUFTWAFFE IN ROMANIA. COMMANDER OF GERMAN COMMAND IN OIL-PRODUCING PLOESTI AREA. IN CHARGE OF ANTI-SABOTAGE ACTIVITIES.. AUGUST-SEPTEMBER 1944: CAPTURED BY ROMANIANS AND TAKEN TO POW CAMP AND ESCAPED. SEPTEMBER 1944-JUNE 1945: RETURNED TO SIEBENBURGEN--ORGANIZED A SMALL GROUP OF RESISTANCE AGAINST SOVIETS.
