Subject: Hostile Activity of Tourists Visiting Hungary

1. Erich HOFFMANN, born in 1911, citizen of the German Federated Republic, residing West Berlin, systematically travels to Hungary as a journalist and businessman. He is suspected of working with British intelligence. In 1944 when he was an officer in German intelligence he was at the same time an agent of British intelligence. At that time he resided at Budapest. Just before the beginning of the revolt he traveled to Hungary as a journalist. In November 1959 the security organs of the Hungarian Peoples Republic arrested his contact—a Hungarian citizen, who under interrogation admitted that he undertook espionage activity from 1956 on instructions of HOFFMANN. HOFFMANN is primarily interested in military and political information.
