1. The Huey Newton defense groups are planning a support Huey Newton program for the 13th, 14th & 15th of July. Plans call for a "lead up rally" in major East Bay cities - Berkeley, Oakland, Richmond, San Francisco and San Mateo. On the 13th, Berkeley will have its rally on Telegraph Avenue. On the 14th, a rally and picnic will be held at De Fremery Park at 3:00 P.M. On the 15th, they will meet at Merritt College at 9:00 A.M. and then have a rally at Merritt Park across the street from the Alameda County Court House. The rallies are supposed to take place whether or not the Newton trial starts.

2. The Interfaith Clergy Forum (420 - 15th. St. Oakland - 835-0537) have set up a Police-Community Relations. Group leaders are [redacted] Other personalities involved are [redacted] Blacks Strike for Justice [redacted]

Purpose of the group is to harass the so-called establishments conforming with the over all radical views of the EBCO.

3. The Peace & Freedom Party (Movement) and the ~~Black Panther Party~~ are proposing a re-structuring of the Police in Berkeley, Oakland and Richmond. This new structure has the general over all support of the entire Liberal Radical Left element of the East Bay. The proposals are as follows:

1. The cities shall be divided into Black and White Police districts. Each district will have its own Police Dept.
2. Each Police Dept. will be run by 3 Police Commissioners who are appointed by Police Control Boards.
3. The Neighborhood Boards will be composed of representatives elected yearly from each district.
4. The Neighborhood Boards will have the right to hire and fire police officers.
5. Each district will have its own Police Station.
6. Funds for the Police Department will be appropriated for the entire City by the City Council. This program will be in the direction of the Police Control, project of the Peace Freedom Office - 549-0650.

4. The National Emergency Civil Liberties Committee has co-directors [redacted] and [redacted]. Both are and have been active in the ACLU. Their purpose in the Bay Area (July 8-13, 68) is to raise funds and form the affiliate in Northern Calif. The NECLC has spent most of its money in attacking Police Administration in New York and New Jersey.
