1. [redacted]
  - a. All Iraq from Basrah to Mosul was under the full control of the coup government.
  - b. The United States and the West were putting great pressure on the new government: landing British troops in Jordan, United States troops landing in Lebanon and King Husayn's high handed actions.
  - c. Nuri and his colleagues had asked for trouble and got it. The West is now asking for trouble in Iraq and has not learned Nuri's lesson.

2. [redacted] said several times that the West is forcing the coup government into a situation it did not want. This was the reason behind the 20 July announcement that the coup government had signed a defense and security pact with the UAR.
