5. Regarding the KAINZ Case, G KUEHNZ believes that GREENGULF-1 regards this case as closed. GREENGULF-1 stated that their investigation of KAINZ showed him to be a reliable type of person, serious, intelligent and respectable who made an overall good impression on the Austrian police authorities. He further stated that he had no objections against KAINZ continuing to work for the Organization in Austria. DIPPER Headquarters is reserving decision on his future use pending receipt of a plan on this from G WAIKE. G KUEHNZ then stated that they have as yet not recovered the material seized by the Austrians from KAINZ. He asked ☐ if we would seek to recover this from GREENGULF-1 or whether the Organization should attempt this. ☐ stated that we preferred the Organization to approach GREENGULF-1 with the request for the return of the documents which, however, we would be interested in seeing. G KUEHNZ stated they would try it.
