MEMORANDUM FOR THE FILE

SUBJECT: General DRO

On 23 June 1952 [ ] British Secret Service (MI-6) representative in Washington, referred to a conversation he had had several weeks previously with [ ] of CIA (see memorandum on this conversation).

[ ] had asked:

- (a) Whether MI-6 still in contact with General DRO;
- (b) What the British evaluation of General DRO's capabilities were.

[ ] said MI-6 still are in contact with DRO; and DRO has told them he is planning to work on stay behind plans with both the Americans and the British.

Outside of this stay behind field DRO has told MI-6 he will continue to work with them; and [ ] people believe him of sufficient potential to continue this working arrangement with him.
