SUBJECT: Russian Anti-Soviet Military Front, Venezuela

Message: General Anton TURCUL

1. Source [REDACTED] reported on 27 March 1951 that General TURCUL had recently written to Major Alexander Petrovitch KHOLODOV stating that he was extremely anxious to emigrate to Venezuela and was doing every possible aid in obtaining a visa. KHOLODOV offered to provide funds of several hundred dollars if such would facilitate the issuance of a visa. He stated that it was too dangerous for him to remain in Germany to conduct his international work and that Venezuela would seem to be an ideal country from which to operate.

2. In his letter TURCUL stated that a congress had recently been held in Munich and Fulda, Germany, under the auspices of the American Military Government and organized under the auspices of an American organization known as the Committee for the Study of Culture in Russia. This congress reportedly demanded the liquidation of all anti-Stalinist Russian Marxist forces for a liberation of Russia from Stalinist imperialism. It was allegedly strongly financed by U.S. circles and directed by KORNENKOV, first chief of the Russian state after the revolution of 1917. TURCUL claims that royalist and rightist Russian groups walked out of the congress, leaving only RDS and Communist anti-Stalin groups participating. TURCUL is vehement in his letter at [REDACTED] the situation and states that, although he is being critical about his feelings in politics, his military movement is definitely going to assume a political character since Russians should not sacrifice their lives fighting Communism and liberating Russia for a "lit" cause.

3. TURCUL feels that he has no chance of getting to the United States in view of his past affiliation with the RDA under German command. He stated that his only home at present was to set to Venezuela.
