On 8 September 1955 Informant 5848 submitted substantially the following information concerning Richard HAUTER-KLATT, bern 6 September 1900 in Vienne, Austria, with effices at Schwarzstrasse 50, Saleburg, Land Salzburg, Austria, which he had obtained from a source in the Austrian State Police (Sundespolisei): Informent 3848 stated that in February 1982 FUBLISCT had one Alexander Feemann visit him in Seleburg. Seemann, an artist, born 18 Birch 1905 in Hodnescovesarthel, Hungary, a Mangarian citisen, had been a number of a dence troups which SindECT had managed in the lellman during world wer II, and which had engaged in estionage activities on behalf of Germany. Several months after Sterann's arrival in Salaburg, one Jose Bakes, a dencer, Jorn 4 June 1898, an Argentine citizen, came co Salaburg, again at the invitation of SMAJECT, SUJJ-CT was planning to organize a new dance troups which was also to be used for intelligence purposes. SHANKOT also brought a hellet troups from Vienns to Salzburg in 1962; the troups trained in Grossgmein near Salzburg, but eventually returned to Vienns, which resulted in a financial loss to S'HJECT. During this time certain remarks made by SUBJECT in conversations indicated that there was a financial dispute between SUBJECT and Seesann, and that SUBJECT was straid of Stemenn's taking legal steps against him. The dispute came to a head in the end of August 1968 when Stemmon filed a formal corolaint with the Salaburg Police which stated that SiBJSCT had embusiled from him 3/4 of a kilogrem of pure gold and 780 American dollars. Investigation disclosed that Ssemann had deposited the gold and dollers with SUBJECT and that SUBJECT, having deposited them at the Berger and Co. Junk on Originasse, Salzburg, spent all the dollars and them morugaced the gold. SUBJECT defended hirself by stating, and furnishing evidence to substantiate his statement, that he had had to support Seemenn, makes, and the Viennese ballot troupe. In spite of his defense, and the feat that our hilf kilogram of gold was still available, an emount of 25,000 schillings was adjudged as still missing. Consequently SUBJECT was apprehended on 81 August 1963 and transferred to the Land Court (Landsagericht) Prison, Salzburg, on 2 September 1958, with beil set at 20,000 schillings, which could not be previded by Dr. Theodor Fell, SUJSOT's lawyer. As soon as Silly CT was transferred to the landergericht Prison, protests were made erainst his arrest by Hofret and Police Mirector Er, Richard Moston and by or. Adelbert Proschko, Salaburg Police Official. The protests were withdrawn when the prosecutor insisted on SUNDECT's imprisonment for violation of the informent 3848 stated that he considered it understandable that Proschie should intervene for SUBJUCT, eince both came from the same area, but he could not exclain Joehn's intervention except through Soehn's friendship with Fell,
