2 1. A check of information currently available in 02 files reveals the following concerning KOMIYA Yoshitaka:

a. Information from a usually reliable source dated 17 December 1945, indicates that one KOMIYA Yoshitaka, a doctor, was reported to have been the founder of a leftist organization in Shanghai called 'Freedom of Thought Club,' which is reported to have been engaged in activities for the Communist Party. (It is noted from KOMIYA's personal data sheet that he was in Shanghai from 1931 to 1946.)

b. Subsequent information dated 24 October 1951, reveals that KOMIYA Yoshitaka, Professor at Gama University, was at that time a councilor of the China Research Institute, a Japan Communist Party front organization.

2. In view of the information cited in paragraph 1 above, 02 is of the opinion that KOMIYA's presence in the United States would present a potential security threat to the United States. Therefore, it is recommended that his visa application be disapproved.

3. It is requested that 02 be informed of final action concerning KOMIYA's application.
