from 1939 - France, Poland, the whole Balkan region, Spain -  
in connection with the war.
23. 4 years Volksschule, 9 years humanistic Gymnasium, 1931 Abitur, immediately following thereon: natural science study at the University in Munich. Studies not completed because of army service.

1 July 1940 Training officer for Gibraltar preparations in France.  
1 May 1941 Training director in Poland for shock troop fighting in the east steppes.  
Company commander - courses for motorized units working with all weapons.  
21 June 1941 Commander of a motorized advance engineer unit and battle up to the Moscow area.  
4 November 1941 General staff troop training with the most varied types of weapons. Commander of various troop units.

5 April 1942 third general staff officer with the 14th Armored Corps.  
1 May 1942 second general staff officer with the 14th Armored Corps.  
1 June 1942 War Academy training in Berlin.  
1 September 1942 Commander of the 369 Great Mountain Engineer Battalion No. 1. Major and Regimental commander in the Balkans.  
1 January 1943 Commander of a German-Great fighting group in the Balkans.  
1 May 1943 Assigned to duty keeping order and pacifying the population, duties primarily of diplomatic character in Bosnia and Albania-Montenegro.  
Autumn 1943 German Commander of the Upper Drina Valley and its adjacent valleys in Bosnia and Montenegro.  
15 September 1943 1st General Staff Officer in the Fuehrer's General Headquarters building positions in the east. In connection with this, important intelligence, organization, construction, and supply duties.  
After setting up and organizing the unit, ordered to the front.  
1 March 1944 Commander of a fighting group with all types of weapons before Kovel.  
1 May 1944 Commander of Jaeger Regiment 56 (active Ula regiment). With this group, outstanding deeds as shock troops ("Feuertocher") in the Army Group Center in the east.  
1 July 1944 Lieutenant Colonel.  
1 October 44 Commander of the Peoples Grenadier Brigade 1077.  
1 January 1945 Colonel  
12 February 1945 Wound in the east.  
From 15 April 1945 With authority from Hitler and Himmler transferred to the 19th Army in southern Germany with special duties for the maintenance of the camps for the German people.  
From 2 May 1945 Commander of Kufrendel and the upper Isar valley in the projected Alpine fortified holding point.  
From 17 May 1945 Gave up my voluntary ties. (Auflösung meines freiwilligen Verbandes).  
Turned myself in as an American POW on 27 May. Arrived at the Neu-Ulm camp, from which I was released on 29 June 1945.  
Dates do not claim to be unconditionally accurate. Single special training courses and smaller important commands are not included.
