1. We assume that ARCAPELIN has written to the theological institute to ask its directors to assist him in getting his visa. This is probably the best way of speeding it.
2. Regarding the new contract, we assumed in suggesting a raise for ARCAPELIN of the equivalent of \$100.00 a month that his salary would cover his living expenses as it previously did in Munich, and that no additional rental allowance would be given him. [] and [] both feel it might be a mistake to do more than double his present salary in one raise as ARCAPELIN has previously been accustomed to and responded well to a gradual series of raises. We furthermore believe that \$200.00 will adequately cover ARCAPELIN's needs in France and that more might tempt him to live beyond his estensible means. We are, of course, assuming that ARCAPELIN will keep for his own use the stipend he receives from the World Council of Churches, and any money he gets from subletting his apartment in Munich.
3. In accordance with the desirability of more frequent, gradual raises in salary, we suggest that ARCAPELIN not be given the full \$100.00 raise in escrow at once, but be informed prior to leaving Munich that his escrow deposits have been raised \$25.00 monthly. We would, however, prefer to have the full amount approved to be awarded at the discretion of the case officer, in whatever form appears most desirable at the time.
