<p>AEDGWA/1 recently received a letter from ANCAVATINA/12 telling of the Mykhailo HRYCIUK arrest as well as of that of Tamara HRYCIUK, who was allegedly held four days before being released. This is substantiated by the attached photocopy of a letter from HRYCIUK to the Free Europe University, informing them that she had again been interrogated by French authorities and stating that her political sympathies were with the UHWA, an anti-Soviet, Ukrainian separatist organization. AEDGWA/1 is trying to identify ANCAVATINA/12's source and any other information on the case.</p>
