Wilhelm Christian KRIECHBAUM (HGLA-7007)

German Police
Oberst KRIECHBAUM - reported in August 1944 to be Feldpolizeichef der Wehrmacht.

VX-740 dated 23 November 1945
Colonel KRIECHBAUM - commanding officer of the Geheime Feldpolizei in Berlin in 1943.

XX-11791 dated 1 May 1945
KRIECHBAUM - Oberst der Polizei and ~~XXXX~~ Chief of the Geheime Feldpolizei, OKW, from 1941 until 1945; born about 1892; 1.70m tall; strong build; gray hair and eyes; chronic eczema on face; comes from Dresden; NSDAP member; member of Abwehr Abt. III.

XX-4864 dated 17 January 1945
SS Standartenfuhrer KRIECHBAUM was second in command of the RSHA Amt IV border inspection station in 1941.

HGLA-1091 dated 17 February 1950
Wilhelm KRIECHBAUM is the chief instructor at the special training course given to the CI officers attached to the various ZIPPER field organizations.

HGLA-48 dated 29 June 1949
Included in list of personalities submitted by ZIPPER as personnel recommended for participation in the German political police organization was Wilhelm KRIECHBAUM of Land Hesse. KRIECHBAUM was born on 7 May 1896 in Wiesbaden, is married, and has one child. He resides in Reichenhall, Wiesbacherstrasse 6. A professional police officer, during the war he was first an instructor in a police school, and finally became the highest official in the GFP, with the rank of General in the OKW. He was a member of the Nazi Party, and is listed as a Group V offender.
