The following information, which was not a part of this file, was provided by another US Government agency in October 2002 as responsive to the Nazi War Crimes Disclosure Act

Franz Krombholz

In his CV from his SS officer's file from the Berlin Document Center, Krombholz indicated that he was assigned to the SS Division Prinz Eugen and was involved in "cleansing" operations beginning in January 1943. These operations were a part of Operation Black, which was an anti-partisan operation conducted by the SS Division Prinz Eugen Division in which whole villages were burned and the inhabitants slaughtered.
