Files here contain nothing on Wilhelm KUEPPER either. There is a Dr. Wilhelm KUEPPERS, born 17 Feb 10 at Munich-Gladbach, but he now resides in Rome. X
STUDERMAYER contacted this KUEPPERS in July 1949 (MGLA-711). He is employed by the UTECOM Co. in Rome and is apparently engaged in intelligence activities for the Italians and others.

It would appear from the [] intercepts that Herman ISENBERG and Wilhelm KUEPPER are in contact with each other with ref to certain matters in the Oberhausen/Sterkrade area, where KUEPPER is occupied with running down traces; that ISENBERG has been busying himself with matters in the Berlin area in conjunction with Err SCHUELER which also involved a search for something; and that Hans HAUSAMANN (and the Swedes) also may be interested in the results of ISENBERG's efforts.

a. After first writing to ISENBERG (address, Oberhausen/Sterkrade), KUEPPER went to Sterkrade and later reported to [] that further "tracing" would take him to the Dusseldorf area for some days; he referred, presumably in the same connection to "die G.H.H.," Herr HERMANN and Herr WAN. The nature of the information and the projects which KUEPPER is pursuing is unknown, although it seems possible that the records of former personnel who worked on a specific munition item are sought.

7. "Meanwhile, the search for wartime records on the "42 machine gun continues. One of [] legmen, Hermann ISENBERG, has been busy tracing the Maget Maschinen- und Geratebau Tegel G.m.b.H. records and both ISENBERG and Wilhelm KUEPPER have been checking in Oberhausen/Sterkrade, probably at Gutehoffnungshuette, where the latter has been working in connection with two of [] projects.
