1. Subject is identified in [ ] and Rome Questura files as Giorgio Pietro DOMM, son of Giuseppe and of Erna nee MANN, born at Berlin, Germany, on 23 September 1915 .
2. During WW-II he served with the German Army, and at war's end was captured at Caspobasso, Italy, as a German-Italian interpreter. Upon the arrival of the Allies he was interned; after release he worked in Allied military camps at Milan and Naples .
3. Suspected of assisting the escape of German POW's from Allied camps, and having declared himself a political refugee in order to avoid being repatriated to Germany, in June 1948 he was confined to the Francobello Italian refugee center in the Province of Frosinone .
4. There, in December 1948, he married Miss Erina Emma MANNONI, who is the daughter of Amadeo and of Maria nee MARETTA, born on [ ] 20 August 1919, then residing in Rome, former employee of the [ ] Embassy at Berlin .
5. In 1949, on subject's own instances, and on the basis of the fact that he had found employment in Rome with the C.I.T.A. (Comitato Italiano per la parte Automobilistica) firm, he was released from Francobello and granted an unlimited Italian sojourn permit. He then went to live in the [ ] home at No. 90 Via Savoia in Rome. In 1950 he and his wife transferred to the latter's small country house located between Velletri and Genzano outside Rome .

6. On 14 July 1953 Subject was arrested at Bruges, Belgium, at the request of the German Police by whom he was wanted for swindling. In 1954 he was sentenced to one year's imprisonment by the Frankfurt courts on that charge .
7. Holder of an Italian Stateless Persons travel document following his release from the Fraschette refugee center, at one subsequent point Subject was also in possession of a false German passport in the name of Ludwig Robert Georg WHEPE, born at Gottingen on 5 August 1911 .
8. Subsequent to 1954 no traces are held on Subject or his family, or on his father Giacomo, now 77 years old, who briefly visited Rome in 1952 .
