1. Forwarded herewith is FBQ Part I on Dieter LACHERT the son of the SUBJECT of reference.

2. Dieter LACHERT fled the DDR on 5 January 1957 and joined his Mother.

* 3. His escape story is as follows: The SUBJECT's Uncle Gustav WACHOW, Pflanzstr, 113 E, Berlin - Lichtenberg, sent him a letter which was received on 4 January 1957 inviting him to visit on the weekend of 5-6 January. The letter included greetings from Hildegard (SUBJECT's Mother) and from this he deduced that his Mother had been released from prison in Poland and was in Berlin. He thereupon replied by telegram stating that he would come to E. Berlin per the invitation. He departed Pflanzstr/Oder by train on Saturday at approximately 11:00 hours arriving E. Berlin at approximately 1700 hours. Enroute he changed from the train to the S-Bahn at BUNDE, changing once again at OST from S-Bahn for the S-Bahn connection to Lichtenberg S-Bahn where he left the train. He then searched for the street location finally finding it after extensive walking. He was controlled on the way several times by cursory examination of his IDP. From his IDP he learned that both his Mother and Sister were in W. Berlin and that they could be contacted through the Refugee Center at 11 Manteuffelstr. He departed his relatives late at night crossing into W. Berlin via the S-Bahn. He alighted at Botanischer Garten Bahnhof in W. Berlin. He
