This man was described as 34, a Lithuanian, with Identity Document No. 20912/18102. He had an ordinary visa, and he went to the Hotel Carrera. He was traveling with two minors named Juris and Mario.
- Also listed in the same memorandum is one Tamara nee LAIPENICKS MATISONS, noted as having also arrived by air on 14 December 1947. She is listed as 26 years old, a Lithuanian, Identity Document No. 209-13/18103, traveling with an ordinary visa. She was born in Latvia. She was also going to the Hotel Carrera.
- 4. It is thought that LAIPENICKS is identical with the person who was coach of the Chilean Olympic Track Team that went to Melbourne, Australia. _____ knows that person casually. If so, it is known that he returned via the U.S.A. from Australia. Further he has arranged a scholarship for his son at the University of Southern California and the son is expected to enter the school in September.
