The Alien Affairs Office of the Directorate has inquired of Immigration and Naturalization the status of Subject's case and has been advised by INS as follows: "Subject is not amenable to deportation under existing laws". It is our understanding that INS has advised their San Diego office to cease any action against Laipenieks. In view of this, we suggest that the response to Subject inform him of the above and that it not be framed as a listing of file contents released and denied. Hence we are not responding to the documents referred from OS files.
