

MEMO 351, 1 September 1949

Subject: ODEUM - Hans KUKOWITSCH, et al.

Para. 3. ...ODEUM claims to have traces on only one Viktor LARIONOV who is termed a former member of the intelligence department of the VLASSOV army, who emigrated from France to Germany where he lived in Wangen at Allgau, and who was carded as a French agent. BARANOWSKI himself reported the above, but two other independent ODEUM sources state that this Viktor LARIONOV was murdered in the summer of 1946 (date of report: 20 September 1946). If the last statement about LARIONOV is true, he could have been executive assistant for CE matters to BARANOWSKI for ODEUM since BARANOWSKI's formal employment by ODEUM did not begin until well after the time of the supposed murder. We shall, of course, ask BARANOWSKI for clarification and inform you if he, in fact, has the same or another Viktor LARIONOFF on his staff.
