1. Subject it a naturalized 3.5. citizen horn in Verpiebelge, latvia on 7 Jone 1919. He was formorly employed in a contract especity by this Agency and was terminated in late 1959 after showing evidence of esortional instability and disturbance. He was added to find suitable outside employment and was provided with a contact to be used in case of necessity.

- 2. In late Movember 1904 LAUMANS passed through Washington from May York (where he is residing) on a trip to Lallas, Toxes to visit his despiter. In Washington he visited an old friend of the same pational background who is a terront contact of this Agoncy, he told his friend that his personal circumstances are desperate. He is having difficulty in finding work, he is behind so his tent and car payments, and is shout to be diverced from his wife. His sent is in a mental institution. Purther, he is distillusioned with what he considers to be a lack of interest on the part of U.S. Servement agencies in his native latvis. He gave his friend to underpicad that he was considering totarning to latvin if he could find money for the trip. His friend attempted to dispusse his, but is not cartain whether his arguments were given weight.
- 3. Subject's last jeb was with a New York construction first owned by Janie RISSERG'S, a forcer Latvian sational. LADMACS last known address is 310 West 19th Street, New York City, a rocaing house.
- 4. Through his friend we are attempting to reack LADMACS and to determine whether any beasures can be taken to persuade him not to return to Latvia. Other individuals in the Latvian emigre colony both in Mashington and East York are awars of Subject's difficulties and are also attempting to aid him.
