- 1. Area of Coperations and Headquarters: Germany, Karlsruhe (Berlin Operations Base)
- 2. References: The operational lead was provided by CAUTERY-3 and exploited in cooperation with CAISSON-19 and CAUTERY-2.
- 3. Aims: a) Objectives: Economic data, especially labor statistics. Personality and organizational information on the Staatliche Flammas Kommission.
  - b) Targets: Staatliche Planungs Kommission, Ministries of Heavy Industry, Light Industry and Machine Construction, specific factories except SAO's,
  - c) Tasks : To gather data listed under a), to provide personality leads for recruitment purposes which come to him by virtue of his official position.
- 4. Personnel: a) CADUCITY
  b) MIB-A-7656 dated 1 January 1951.
- 5. Cover: Agent is in a position to gather the above-mentioned data in the normal performance of his duties. Case officer represents U.S. intelligence.

- 6. Contact and Communications: Safe house debriefings. Agent can call on the special agent phone. Date of meetings and place of pick-up pre-extranged at previous meeting.
- 7. Control: Partly ideological, mainly by satisfying agent's desire for personal and financial security should he be forced to flee to Western Germany. Agent has signed receipts for money received. Unless controlled by the RIS, his working relationship with the AIS, should it become known to his superiors, would result in severe punishment. Agent's compensation will be deposited and held in esserow until termination of contract. His wife and child live in the Eastern Sector of Berlin.
- 8. Special Equipment: Hone at present.
- 9. Coordination: None
- 10. Timetable: Engagement started on 1 January 1951.
- 11. Estimated Costs
  - A. Retroactive approval of expenses incurred in agent's recruitment, amounting to 572 IM West, is requested. In order to establish the initial contact, agent, under pretense of a social invitation, had to be entired into the Western Sector. Entertainment had to be provided for agent, CAISSON-19, CAUTENT-3 and CAUTENT-2, the operational plan calling for lavishness in keeping with agent's expensive tastes.
  - B. Compensation of 2h00 DM West from 1 January to 30 June 1951, to be deposited in monthly installments of h00 DM West.
  - C. Special operating fund to be used at case officer's discretion for non-requirent purposes for the period from 1 January to 30 June 1951: 300 DM West.
  - D. Regular monthly supply of coffee, liquor and fats.
- 12. Special Problems and Commitments: Disposal commitments, including agent's wife and child, comprise provision of secure travel to the West, procurement of residential permit and a testimonial of service.
