1. In about July 1953 Major Vaciliy Mikhaylovich SHGRMIKOV of the OHU legal residency in Vienna proposed to recruit three Austrians holding positions in the Austrian government, (Inu) LIMHARDT/LIMHARDT, (Inu) PACHLER, and (Inu) SHIDLER/EHDLER. However, these persons had been recruited prior to that time by a Transborder Intelligence Point (MU). (Which recruiting element was not positively identified, but it was considered probable that LIMHARDT, PACHLER, and SHIDLER were being run by a Transborder Intelligence Point located at the Gentral Komendatura in Vienna, under Golomel Pavel Mikolayevich PAPPE, or possibly by the Vienna HU Intelligence Point headed by Golomel Mikhail Vasilyevich HEREEKIM.)

LIMBARDT/LIMBEARDT was described as working in the Austrian Ministry of State Security" (probably the Ministry of the Interior), as was PAGHLER. LIMBARDT's position was not further described; PAGHLER was referred to as a secretary. SKIDLER/KRIDLER was then serving as one of the two personal secretaries to Adolf SCHARRY [then Vice-Chancellor under Julius RAAR, now President of Austria].

COMMENT: Following are the results of preliminary Headquarters traces on PICHLER, suggested as possibly identical with PACHLER:

PICHLER, Dr. Joseph: Drs. Joseph Pichler and Dr. Peter Pichler are identical as Dr. Peter Pichler's address, as reflected in a FOLET/2 report, dated 22 August 1950, is Vienna IVII, Gerathoferstr. Ei, and in the 1950 Vienna Telephone Book, Dr. Josef FICHLER Hindskr, is listed as residing at this address. FOLET 2 files refer to a Peter Pichler who works in Graf's office, whereas other documents, such as the Amtekalendar, refer to a Josef Pichler.

80B 1575, dated 7 Jamery 1955, to 00B, Vienna, states USFA, 6-2, CIC, Det 35, have no traces on Dipl. Ingr. Joseph PICHIER.

Det 35 Report IOR-1641, 19 Harch 1952 - Report on Otto Schmab disappearance (former employee of h30th GIG Sub Det "C", Vienna). Dr. Josef Pichler is listed, among many others, as having known about Schmab. Pichler is contact to Ferdinand Graf, State Secretary-Ministry of Interior, contact of Albert L. Olson, employed by GIG and Alfred J. Bittner, former employee of GIC, later emigrated to Gandda.

XOR 2635, dated 1 February 1952, states WOODBURY 230 check with Dr. Josef Fichler re Kriminal Inspektor Hart'l reliability. Pichler stated Hartl was 100 per cent anti-Gommunist.

MAVA 9763, dated 5 November 1951, re Stephan KIRIPOLSKY and Vojtech GERSHA. Stephan KIRIPOLSKY states a Josef Hofinger, Amstrian citizen of Hungarian origin who was formerly employed with IBO in Vienna, but lost his job through "Osech" ("Osech" is cover name for an employee in Voice of America or Radio Free Europe who paid HOFINGER sums of money for occastional information). HOFINGER, at present, is trying to get employment with a conscrahip office in Vienna. KIRIPOLSKY stated ROFINGER is in close contact with Himisterialsberkamiesar Dr. Josef PICHLER.

2. Traces from _ _ Pile on Peter PICHLER.

Report, dated 22 August 1950, Evaluation F-3: "State Secretary Graf and his closest associates". Source is a whose main informat is leopold HARTL. CRAP's representative in matters of police and gendarmerie. (Extract re Dr. Peter Pichler): "HAF e legal concultant, particularly on Masi questions, is Dr. Peter FICHLER. He is a personal friend and they associate extensively on a social basis. Both are from Carinthia and Mrs. PICHLER is a former secretary of GRAF's. Br. PICHLER was born 13 April 1917 in Carinthia. He currently resides at Vienna IVIII, Gerethoferetr. 24. He is the son of a medical doctor and is a member of a C.V. Fraternity (Certel Verband). He has a steadfast open character, is emert, industrious, and arbitious. He is quite acceptable socially. He is devoted to his family and to his work, but still finds time for sports. FIGHIER carries on political lisison in GBAP's name with Villach, Klagenfurt, and to a certain extent, with the other major cities in Austria. The police officials of the larger Austrian cities are all either friends or freternity brothers of his. He has been commetted with private Austrian negotiations with lite."

Progress Report for August and September 1950:
held a general conversation with Dr. Peter PICHLER, GRAF's legal consultant on some questions on 7 September 1950.
On the evening of September 12,
was scheduled to entertain PICHLER, HARTL, and their wives; report of this meeting has not yet been received.

3. Trees on Dr. Brich PICHLER

TS Document 37646, 14 December 1949, MAVA 4328, "Tth Meeting with ____", reports Paul Wilhelm MEINIMER (Minister of the Austrian Legation in Budapest) and Brich PICHLER (2nd man in Austrian Legation, Budapest) were duped into issuing a passport to an agent of the Hungarian Intelligence Service (Rosa Schober) and transported her valuables from Budapest to Vienna, and later from Vienna to Berne via Austrian courier. Minister Gruber was enraged at both.

From TS Document 57139, 17 April 1951, NAVA 8124: CRUMER requested all Austrian Foreign Office posts in Satellite countries for troop movements and concentrations. Erich PICHLER, who has been with the Politicel Section, has been in charge of this incoming material. He prepares summaries for Gruber.

MAY 2697, 30 March 1951, Evaluation F-3: Dr. Erich PICHIER, Legation Secretary, Second Class, will probably be sent to Lagrab as Austrian Consul. He is now Legal Section (Abteilung 6 RA) of the Foreign Office, and is scheduled to spend six months as Gruber's secretary in the Minister's cabinet before being sent to Iugoslavia. Source Comment: PICHIER was drafted into the German Away at the outbreak of war. Shortly after his return to the Foreign Office in 1946, he was sent to Budapest. His father, Dipl. Ing. Earl PICHIER, is employed as a senior official in the Ministry of Social Welfare.

Erich PICHLER, JDR. LegR JKl, listed in 195h and 1955 Amtskalender as No. 2 Man in Minister to Germany's office located in Bonn.
