ISRAELI PAPERS COMMENT ON ALLOU-KISSINGER MEETING, SETTLEMENT

(TEXT) HA'ARIV AGAIN CRITICIZES THE MEETING WHICH FOREIGN MINISTER VIGAL ALLOU WILL HAVE WITH DR KISSINGER TOMORROW. THE PAPER SAYS THAT IT APPEARS FROM REPORTS PUBLISHED IN WASHINGTON AND JERUSALEM THAT THE TWO SIDES ARE NOT SPARING ANY EFFORT IN ORDER TO INSURE THAT THE MEETING WILL NOT PRODUCE ANY USEFUL RESULTS. IN THE PAPER'S OPINION, IT WAS IMPOSSIBLE TO PREPARE A MEETING IN A WORSE WAY. ISRAEL IS DECLARING THAT MINISTER ALLOU IS NOT CARRYING ANY NEW IDEAS, AND DR KISSINGER IS ANNOUNCING THAT THERE IS NO POINT IN RESUMING HIS MISSION WITHOUT NEW IDEAS.

YEDI'OT ANAROT MAKES AN ANALOGY BETWEEN THE SITUATION IN INDOCHINA AND THE SITUATION IN OUR REGION. THE PAPER SAYS DR KISSINGER SHOULD BE ASKED TODAY WHETHER HE HAD DELUDED HIMSELF, FELL VICTIM TO DECEIT, OR MISLED HIS PEOPLE AND THE FREE WORLD. ISRAEL, IN THE PAPER'S OPINION, IS AMONG THOSE WHICH STILL INNOCENTLY BELIEVE THAT IT IS POSSIBLE TO RELY ON PROMISES OF NON-BELLIGERENCY AND GUARANTEES BY FOREIGN AND DISINTERESTED BIG POWERS.
