HAIFA OIL REFINERY  
RAIDED BY SYRIAN JET

DAMASCUS, SYRIA (AP)-- SYRIAN JETS RAIDED ISRAEL'S MAIN OIL REFINERY AT HAIFA "IN RETALIATION FOR ISRAELI AIR ATTACKS ON OUR ECONOMIC INSTALLATIONS," THE SYRIAN COMMAND ANNOUNCED TODAY.

DAMASCUS ADD RAID (18)

A COMMUNIQUE BROADCAST BY DAMASCUS RADIO SAID: "IN RETALIATION FOR ENEMY ATTACKS ON SOME OF OUR ECONOMIC TARGETS AND INSTALLATIONS, OUR AIR FORCE BOMBED THIS MORNING THE OIL REFINERY IN HAIFA."

THE COMMUNIQUE APPARENTLY REFERRED TO ISRAELI AIR AND NAVAL ATTACKS ON OIL DEPOTS AT THE PORT OF TARTUS, SYRIA'S OIL REFINERY AT HOMS, IN THE CENTRAL PART OF THE COUNTRY, AND ITS PIPELINE TERMINAL AT BANIAS, ON THE MEDITERRANEAN COAST.

THE SYRIAN OIL INSTALLATIONS HAVE BEEN HIT SEVERAL TIMES BY ISRAELI JETS AND NAVAL GUNBOATS. THE LAST AIR ATTACK ON SYRIAN OIL INSTALLATIONS AT TARTUS, ALSO ON THE COAST, OCCURRED FOUR DAYS AGO.
