(TEXT) THE CABINET HAS JUST ENDED A SESSION WHICH
LASTED SEVERAL HOURS. AT THE END OF THE SESSION, THE CABINET
ANNOUNCED THAT THE ISRAELI GOVERNMENT'S POSITIVE, PRINCIPLED
POSITION REGARDING THE SIGNING OF A CEASE-FIRE AGREEMENT WITH
EGYPT IS STILL IN EFFECT. IT WAS ALSO STATED THAT FURTHER
CONTACTS WILL BE HELD WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF THE U.S.
GOVERNMENT ON THE SUBJECT.

THE PRIME MINISTER REPORTED AT THE CABINET SESSION ON HER
TALKS WITH THE U.S. AMBASSADOR CONCERNING THE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN ISRAEL, EGYPT AND THE UNITED STATES REGARDING THE
CEASE-FIRE ARRANGEMENTS ON THE EGYPTIAN FRONT. MAJ GEN AHARON
YARIV REPORTED ON HIS TALKS WITH EGYPTIAN REPRESENTATIVES.
THE CLAUSES OF THE AGREEMENT WERE DISCUSSED.
