MOSCOW IN ENGLISH TO GREAT BRITAIN AND IRELAND AT 2100 GMT
ON 10 OCTOBER BROADCASTS A REPORT ON SYRIAN-SOVIET COMMUNIQUE ON AL-
ASAD'S VISIT WHICH STATES:

"THE LEADERS OF THE SOVIET UNION AND SYRIA HAVE DISCUSSED THE
PRESENT MIDDLE EAST SITUATION AND ITS INFLUENCE ON THE INTERNATIONAL
SITUATION AS A WHOLE. THIS IS SAID IN A STATEMENT ON THE SOVIET-
SYRIAN TALKS HELD IN MOSCOW. THE TALKS INVOLVED LEONID BREZHNEV,
NIKOLAY PODGORNY, ALEKSEY KOSYGIN, ANDREY GROMYKO AND ANDREY
GRECHKO, AND ALSO PRESIDENT HAFIZ AL-ASAD OF SYRIA AND THE PEOPLE
ACCOMPANYING HIM. BOTH SIDES STRESSED THEIR DETERMINATION TO DO
EVERYTHING IN THEIR POWERS TO RESTORE AND SAFEGUARD THE LEGITIMATE
RIGHTS OF THE ARAB STATES AND THE ARAB PEOPLE, INCLUDING THE
PALESTINIAN ARABS. THE LEADERS OF THE TWO COUNTRIES EXPRESSED
THEIR UNBENDING WISH TO CONTINUE CEMENTING THEIR FRIENDSHIP.
NO ONE, IT WAS UNDERSCORED, WILL BE ALLOWED TO SHAKE THAT FRIENDSHIP
OR DAMAGE IT. THE TALKS TOOK PLACE IN ATMOSPHERE OF FRIENDSHIP,
CORDIALITY AND COMPLETE MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING. THE SOVIET
LEADERSHIP TODAY GAVE A LUNCHEON FOR THE SYRIAN DELEGATION.
LATER IN THE DAY, PRESIDENT AL-ASAD LEFT FOR HOME."

HOSTAGES LEAD

BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA (AP) -- ALGERIA HAS AGREED TO ACCEPT 10 LATIN
REFUGEES HOLDING FIVE HOSTAGES IN A UNITED NATIONS OFFICE HERE,
SPECIAL U.N. ENVOY JOHN KELLY ANNOUNCED TODAY.

THE REFUGEES BURST INTO THE BUENOS AIRES OFFICE OF THE U.N. HIGH
COMMISSION FOR REFUGEES WEDNESDAY AND SEIZED 10 HOSTAGES TO PROTEST
THEIR LIVING CONDITIONS IN ARGENTINA. THEY DEMANDED SAFE PASSAGE TO
ANOTHER COUNTRY.
