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CLEARLY SUGGESTS INCREASING ENEMY STRENGTH WEST OF ROUTE 1. THIS ACTIVITY, WHEN COUPLED WITH CONTINUING HEAVY PRESSURE WEST OF HUE, SUPPORTS THE CONCLUSION THAT THE ENEMY IS PREPARING FOR A MAJOR OFFENSIVE EFFORT IN THESE AREAS. IF SUCH AN EFFORT IS MADE, THE ARVN FORCES WILL BE HARD PRESSED TO HOLD THEIR CURRENT POSITIONS ON THE WEST FLANK. PRESENTLY ALL ARVN FORCES IN NORTHERN MR 1, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE CORPS RESERVE OF ONE INF REGT OF THREE BNS, ARE COMMITTED. CONSIDERATION AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL HAS BEEN GIVEN TO REINFORCING LAMSON 72 FORCES. CG IV CORPS HAS BEEN ALERTED TO PREPARE THE 7TH DIV FOR MOVEMENT OUT OF MR 4. DATES AND AREAS OF EMPLOYMENT ARE NOT YET KNOWN.

ACTIVITY IN THE MARINE AO FOCUSED ON THE MARINE ELEMENTS THAT COMBAT ASSAULTED YESTERDAY. CONTACT WAS ESTABLISHED SOON AFTER LANDING. MARINES KILLED 73 ENEMY AND DESTROYED ONE TANK. MARINE LOSSES WERE FOUR KILLED AND 24 WOUNDED. IN THE ARVN AO ENEMY GUNNERS CONTINUED TO TARGET ARVN ELEMENTS AS THEY RECEIVED EIGHT ABF OF OVER 254 ROUNDS RESULTING IN THREE ARVN KILLED AND FIVE WOUNDED. IN TWO SCATTERED CONTACTS ARVN ELEMENTS KILLED 16 ENEMY, DESTROYED ONE TANK AND CAPTURED ONE 122MM FIELD GUN AND FIVE TONS OF 122MM AMMUNITION. ENGAGEMENTS IN THE VIC OF FSB NANCY FOLLOW RECENT ENEMY RECONNAISSANCE AND PROBING ACTIONS AND INDICATE THAT THE 364TH NVA DIV FORCES HAVE BEEN POSITIONED TO MAINTAIN PRESSURE AGAINST THE ARVN WESTERN FLANK. IN THE 1ST DIV AO FSB BASTOGNE AND VIC RECEIVED ABF OF OVER 724 ROUNDS. ARVN CASUALTIES INCLUDED THE XO, S-3 AND S-5 OF THE 1/30 INF WHO WERE KIA, WHILE THE CO WAS WOUNDED. THE SHARP INCREASE IN ABF AGAINST 1ST DIV ELEMENTS IS VIEWED WITH CONCERN. INDICATIONS ARE THAT AN ATTACK AGAINST BASTOGNE MAY BE IMMINENT. 1ST DIV ELEMENTS ARE CONDUCTING SPOILING OPERATIONS TO THE W AND SW OF THE BASTOGNE/CHECKMATE AREA, HOWEVER, PROGRESS IS SLOW. ENEMY ELEMENTS THAT LAUNCHED THE ABF AGAINST BASTOGNE AND THE ARVN FORCES IN THE AREA TO THE W ARE PROBABLY ELEMENTS OF THE 6753 ARTILLERY REGT. ADDITIONALLY, POSSIBLE ELEMENTS OF THE 324 NVA DIV WERE PROBABLY INVOLVED IN CONTACTS AGAINST 1ST DIV ELEMENTS TO THE SE OF BASTOGNE.

INVOLVED SMALL SKIRMISHES WITH FLEETING ENEMY UNITS. ARVN FORCES CONTINUE TO MOVE RATHER FREELY WITHIN THE OPERATIONAL AREA. ENEMY RESISTANCE CAN BE EXPECTED TO STIFFEN AS FRIENDLY UNITS MOVE N.
