- 2. JOE KRAFT HAS AN OP ED "MISSION TO MOSCOW," WITH THE SAME THEME AS THE MARDER PIECE BUT A LITTLE MORE OPTIMISM. HE CONCLUDES THAT THE SOVIETS WILL TRY TO WRAP UP AGREEMENTS WHILE NIXON IS STILL PRESIDENT—THE CRUCIAL QUESTION IS ON WHAT TERMS. KRAFT CONCLUDES THAT IN SALT YOU NEED TO GO BEYOND LIMITING MIRVS TO PUT A LID ON THE SOVIET UNION'S MASSIVE BUILD—UP.
