MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY THE SITUATION ROOM FROM: MORNING NEWS SUMMARY SUBJECT: THE WASHINGTON POST AMBASSADOR DINITZ DESCRIBED HIS TALK WITH YOU AS "LONG AND CON-STRUCTIVE, WHICH, ACCORDING TO VICTOR ZORZA, COMES CLOSE TO DESCRIBING THE STRIAN PROPOSAL ITSELF AS CONSTRUCTIVE. (A-1) THE ISRAELI CARETAKER CABINET APPOINTED MAJOR GENERAL GUR AS CHIEF OF STAFF, SUCCEEDING ELAZAR.
