HONG KONG (UPI) -- SENATE REPUBLICAN LEADER HUGH SCOTT SAID TODAY RELATIONS BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND CHINA MAY NOT BE UPGRADED UNTIL AFTER THE DEATH OF CHINESE COMMUNIST PARTY LEADER MAG ISE-TURN AND NATIONALIST CHINESE PRESIDENT CHIANG KAI-SKEK.

IN A SPEECH TO THE FOREIGH CORRESPONDENT'S CLUB, SCOTT SAID FULL DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN CHINA AND THE UNITED STATES PROBABLY WILL HAVE TO "WAIT UNTIL ANOTHER GENERATION TAKES OVER."

ASKED IF THAT MEANT VAITING UNTIL AFTER THE DEATHS OF MAC OR CHIANG OR BOTH, SCOTT REPLIED, "I SUPPOSE I WAS AT LEAST MINITING THAT. I DON'T THINK IT'S (FULL DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS) POSSIBLE WITH THIS GENERATION.

"VE HAVE SEEN COUNTRIES WHERE THE ADVENT OF A NEW GENERATION WAS THE ADVENT OF A NEW APPROACH." SCOTT SAID, CITING THE BREAKTHROUGH IN US-CHINA RELATIONS WHICH OCCURRED WHEN FORMER PRESIDENT RICHARD WIXON, A REPUBLICAN, REPLACED DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENT LYMBON JOHNSON.

MAO IS 88 AND CHIANG. PRESIDENT OF THE NATIONALIST CHINESE GOVERNMENT ON TAIWAN, IS 87. THE UNITED STATES MAG A MISSIGN IN PEXING BUT DOES NOT HAVE FULL DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS WITH CHINA.

PERING AND TAIPEL BOTH AGREE TAIWAN BELONGS TO CHIMA BUT BOTH ALSO CONSIDER THEMSELVES THE OBLY LEGAL CRIMESE GOVERNMENTS.

SCOTT SAID HE DID NOT BELIEVE RELATIONS BETWEEN PEKING AND WASHINGTON HAVE ACTUALLY SLIPPED SINCE NIXON'S BREAKTHROUGH VISIT IN 1972.

"MY OWN VIEW IS THAT WE ARE STILL ON PROBATION WITH THE PEOPLES REPUBLIC OF CHINA," SCOTT SAID. "THE USER STILL IS PUBLIC ENERY NO. 1 (TO THE CHINESE). I THINK THEY (CHINA) MAVE BEEN PREDOCUPTED WITH THEIR OWN INTERNAL AFFAIRS FOR AWAILE."
