SUBJECT: MORNING NEWS SUMMARY

THE WASHINGTON POST

THE UN MOVED FRIDAY TOWARD THE ADOPTION OF AN ARAB RESO-
LUTION DEFINING ZIONISM AS A FORM OF RACISM IN THE FACE OF
A BLUNT AMERICAN WARNING THAT "THIS RESOLUTION PLACES THE
WORK OF THE UN IN JEOPARDY." THE U.S. CLAIMED THAT BY DE-
TERMINING "THAT ZIONISM IS A FORM OF RACISM AND RACIAL DIS-
CRIMINATION" AS THE RESOLUTION SAYS, THE UN WOULD "OFFICIALLY
ENDORSE ANTI-SEMITISM." (A-1)

MUTINOUS TROOPS ACCUSED PORTUGAL'S NORTHERN MILITARY COM-
MAND IN OPORTO FRIDAY OF RENEGING ON AN AGREEMENT AND
THREATENED ARMED REVOLT UNLESS THE SITUATION CHANGED.
THEY SAID THEY WERE SEEKING SUPPORT FROM OTHER UNITS OF THE
ARMED FORCES AROUND THE COUNTRY. (A-1)

PRIME MINISTER RABIN SAID THURSDAY THAT ISRAEL CAN MANAGE
WITHOUT THE U.S.-BUILT PERSHING SURFACE-TO-SURFACE MISSILE
AND THE ISSUE SHOULD NOT BECOME A TEST CASE OF AMERICAN-
ISRAELI RELATIONS. RABIN ALSO SAID ISRAEL DOES NOT SEE
THE POSSIBILITY OF NEGOTIATING AN INTERIM SETTLEMENT WITH
SYRIA SIMILAR TO THE SINAI ACCORD WITH EGYPT. HE INDICATED
THAT ISRAEL WOULD REQUIRE MORE FROM SYRIA IN ANY NEW AGREE-
MENT THAN A COMMITMENT "NOT TO RESORT TO THE THREAT OR USE
OF FORCE" -- THE WORDING OF THE CENTRAL CLAUSE IN THE SINAI
ACCORD. (A-5)
