The President then turned to Chile. He wanted to point out that Chile is not yet down the pike. He wanted the British to give no encouragement to the idea that this government might prove acceptable until the die is cast and Allende has become President. He hoped that the British would suspend loans and other matters of this kind. Home said he would look into it.

The meeting then broke up because the President had to leave to keep his schedule in Ireland.

On the way from the helicopter, Heath asked me what I thought, and I told him it was a successful meeting and that the President had been very relaxed. Heath clearly felt the same way.
