SUBJECT: Suggested US Guest List for The Diplomatic Reception, October 5, 9:00 p.m.

Lucy Winchester has asked for our recommendations on the State Department (Protocol) suggested list of US invitees to the Diplomatic Corps Reception on October 5 (Tab B). We have reviewed the guest list for the last White House Diplomatic Reception in 1971 (Tab C), and have prepared an NSC-proposed list at Tab A.

The State Department list includes the Chief Justice, the Speaker of the House, President Pro Temp of the Senate, and the total membership of the Senate Foreign Relations and House Foreign Affairs Committees, a total of approximately 60 Congressmen plus their wives. They have also included the Directors of CIA, ACDA, USIA and AID, the President of OPIC, and all the State Department Assistant Secretaries or those of Assistant Secretary rank including Barbara Watson, John Thomas, George Vest and George Springsteen. They omit the Apostolic Delegate, who ~~was~~ added to the 1971 list by the White House. Bill Baroody favors inclusion of the Delegate, but State (Protocol) does not because he is not officially a member of the Diplomatic Corps.

State's list totals 130 US invitees and 280 Diplomatic Corps invitees.

We have discussed State's list informally with the Social Office and they agree that Congressmen should not be included in this reception. Our list at Tab A, therefore, excludes the Congressmen, Directors of CIA, ACDA, USIA and AID and the Chairman of OPIC. It includes the geographic Assistant Secretaries of State, plus some people like Hal Sonnenfeldt, Win Lord and Bill Hyland. It includes the Apostolic Delegate. It also includes the NSC Senior Staff members for the geographic areas.

RECOMMENDATION:

That you sign the memo to Lucy Winchester at Tab I forwarding the NSC-proposed list.

In keeping with tradition, I propose that you and Mrs. Ford invite the Chiefs of Diplomatic Missions and their wives to a reception at the White House soon after Labor Day. Representatives of the Organization of American States and their wives should also be included.

It has been the practice of the President to receive and entertain the Diplomatic Corps soon after taking office. President Johnson invited the Diplomatic Corps to a meeting and reception three weeks after his accession to the Presidency. Subsequently, President and Mrs. Johnson held a diplomatic reception each year. President and Mrs. Nixon received the Diplomatic Corps eleven days after his 1969 inauguration. They received the Corps once again in February 1971.

Your Objectives

A diplomatic reception would afford an appropriate opportunity for you to meet all foreign envoys accredited to you, and to extend friendship and goodwill to them; it would, I believe, underscore your dedication to the continuity of United States relations with other countries. I can assure you it would please the Corps to be received.

RECOMMENDATION:

That you and Mrs. Ford invite the Chiefs of Diplomatic Missions and representatives to the OAS with their wives to a reception at the White House. If you agree, the Chief of Protocol will make the necessary arrangements with your staff.
