SUBJECT: INFORMATION ITEMS

USSA INCREASING MILITARY PRESENCE IN TANZANIAL ACCORDING TO DIA, MOSCOW IS REPORTEDLY ESTABLISHING A MILITARY AD-VISORY MISSION IN TANZANIA. THE MISSION WILL BE PRIMA ENGAGED IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AIR DEFENSE SYSTEM, THE MISSION WILL BE PRIMARILY AND BO SOVIET ADVISERS ARE EXPECTED TO ARRIVE IN DAR ES BALAAM HITHIN 90 DAYS. "THEY WILL REMAIN THERE FOR ABOUT 18 MONTHS. ESTABLISHMENT OF THIS MISSION COINCIDES WITH THE RETURN HOME OF SOME 55 TANZANIA PEOPLETS DEFENSE FORCE OFFICERS SENT TO THE USSR IN OCTOBER 1974 FOR RADIO AND ATO DEFENSE RADAR TRAINING. DELIVERIES TO TANZANIA OF SOVIET AIR DEFENSE RADAR EQUIPMENT HAVE ALSO BEGUN. THE AIR DEFENSE SYSTEM IS APPARENTLY PART OF A MILITARY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AGREED UPON BETWEEN MOSCOW AND DAR ES SALAAM A YEAR AGO. AT THAT TIME, THE USSR REPORTEDLY. AGREED TO PROVIDE TANZANIA WITH \$40 MILLION OF MILITARY EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING SAMS, ANTIAIRCRAFT GUNS, AND ARTILM LERY WEAPONS. AN AGREEMENT SIGNED EARLIER IN 1974 AND VALUED AT 834 MILLION CALLED FOR SUPPLYING MIGHELS, SUP-PORT EQUIPMENT, AND TRAINING, MOSCOW IS NO DOUBT PLEASED WITH ITS OPPORTUNITY TO COMPETE SIGNIFICANTLY WITH PEKING IN TANZANIA. THE USSRIS PRESENCE THERE MAY ALSO REFLECT ITS GROWING INTEREST IN EAST AFRICA AS WELL AS THE SOVIET'S DESIRE TO STRENGTHEN ITS POSITION AMONG THE INDIAN OCEAN LITTORAL COUNTRIES.
