1. (SS) The Cuban Armed Forces have gone to an alert posture, possibly in reaction to increased US military activity. One SA-2 surface-to-air missile site in the Havana area was ordered to prepare for a "real alert situation" at 0810 EDT this morning by an unidentified higher headquarters. In addition, the Cuban

2. (S/NFD) This sctivity may be in reaction to increased US military activity as a result of the Middle East situation. However, no anti-US action has yet been noted. An OLYMPIC FIRE U-2 reconnaissance mission has not been reacted to and is presently out of the SA-2 envelope.
