Subject: Liaison Between CII and CIO

Captain Marshall, M.C., U.S.A., is hereby designated as the representative of the CII for liaison between the CII and CIO, responsible for maintenance of all present liaison channels and authorized in advance for arrangements for all new channels of communication which may arise on the liability of equivalent personnel in CII provided for the required information. He is in Room 2204, Republic Building, Atlanta, Georgia, where he can be reached.

It is proposed that in the near future a general plan for coordination of liaison channels will be submitted to CII for consideration. It is requested that all contacts not presently established be through Captain Mather, and that all matters in relation to plans, action or intelligence which are not made the subject of official memo be taken up directly with him. Matters in connection with staff and administration will continue to be taken up with General Hoyt S. Vandenberg in Room 2204, New War Building - telephone, Republic 6762, Atlanta.
